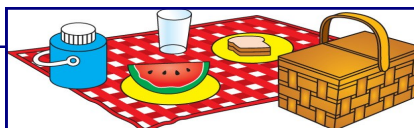

Wildcat
Shredding

The City of Goessel will be contracting with Wildcat Shredding of Newton to provide 2 containers that are secure with locks into which materials to be shredded can be placed. The containers will then be picked up and transported to Wildcat Shredding where they will be shredded. The materials will not be shredded on site but will be transported in a secure vehicle and shredded at a secure facility. Suggested materials for shredding are: old bank statements, checks & check registers, junk mail such as credit card applications, old loan papers, insurance policies, old tax returns, etc. The bins will be available in the **community room of the city building during business hours (8-12 & 1-5 M-T & 8-Noon F) the weeks of June 19-23 & 26-30.** This service is open to Goessel residents only.

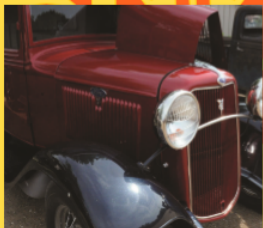

Goessel Community Foundation Awards Scholarships

Two Goessel High School graduates were recently awarded scholarships by the Goessel Community Foundation, an affiliate of Central Kansas Community Foundation.

Gentry Thiesen was selected to receive the Joyful Noise Community Child Care Scholarship in the amount of \$850. The JNCCC award was established to provide financial assistance to a graduate who plans to further their education at a private or public college/university.
